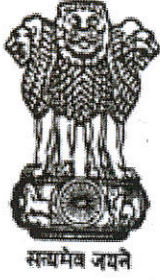

Fresh water requirement shall be met from River Krishna. Prior permission shall be obtained from the concerned regulatory authority/CGWA in this regard, and renewed from time to time. No ground water recharge shall be permitted within the premises"

5. All other terms and conditions stipulated in the environmental clearance granted by the ministry vide letter J-11011/300/2007-IA-II(I) dated 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 shall remain unchanged.

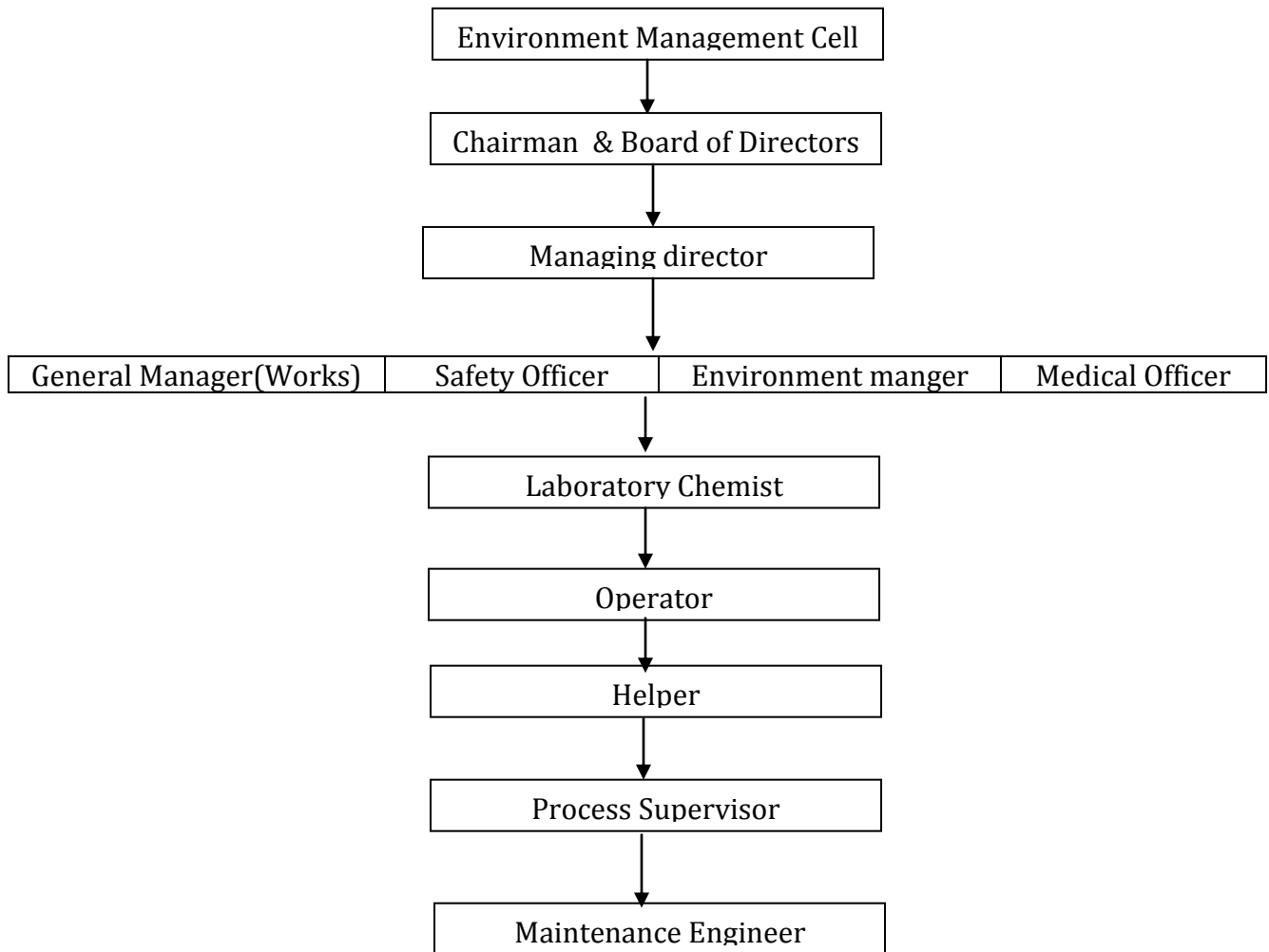
